An overview of the Public Sensitization agenda for communities was shared with the CT. The presentation will be delivered jointly by CZMAI and TNC.

Questions from CT

Will there be the option for anonymous feedback from stakeholders and the general public during stakeholder engagement meetings, on the website, and through other channels in addition to the conflict/grievance mechanism?

MSP coordinator made recommended changes on the flyer.

Conflict/Grievance mechanism will provide for anonymous feedback.

#### Other matters

7.1 Updates from the CEO Executive Committee on key pending matters:
-Approval for the CEO of the Ministry of National Defence and Border

Security to join the CEO Executive Committee (as mentioned in last month's meeting).

-Approval of final BSOP vision, goals and objectives:

The Overarching Goal was approved, with word change from the previous version of this goal, "To sign into law and Gazette the enact and publish legalisation required to legally enforce the Marine Spatial Plan that guides sustainable development and designates up to 30% of Belize's Biodiversity Protection Zones" to "To enact and publish legalisation required to legally enforce the Marine Spatial Plan that guides sustainable development and designates up to 30% of Belize's Biodiversity Protection Zones."

-Goal one - Process Governance Goal, "To design and implement a science-based, data-driven, participatory, equitable, and inclusive MSP process which delivers on Belize's MSP-related commitments under











the Blue Loan Agreement and Conservation Funding Agreement, in conformance with the guiding principles for decision making", was accepted and approved, as is, with no changes.

#### Objectives:

- Objective 1- By November 2022, initiate the process of developing a Marine Spatial Plan for Belize's ocean.
- Objective 2- Develop and implement the necessary mechanisms, processes, and procedures to ensure that the MSP process is functional, effective, and in accordance with the governance framework.
- Objective 3- Following the MSP Process Launch, implement an MSP communications strategy and plan to foster public understanding and support for the MSP process by publicizing its progress and outputs.

-Goal two - Marine Conservation Goal, "To legally protect up to 30% of Belize's Oceans as Biodiversity Protection Zones", was accepted and approved as is. Except for objective number four, where an alternate phrase was chosen to replace "complete, sign into law and Gazette" with "complete enact and publish legalisation(s) to legally enforce", with this change in words to be consistent with the overarching goal.

#### Objectives:

- Objective 1 Design Biodiversity Protection Zones to protect priority habitats, areas, and species identified through the MSP process, integrating climate resilient safeguards.
- Objective 2 Strengthen the Marine Protected Area (MPA) network in conformance with national governance frameworks and ecological, economic, social, and cultural criteria set forth by the IUCN.
- Objective 3 By November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024, sign into law and Gazette Biodiversity Protection Zones covering a total of 25% of Belize's Ocean.
- Objective 4 By November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026, complete, enact and publish legislation(s) to legally enforce the Marine Spatial Plan.
- Objective 5 By November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026, sign into law and Gazette Biodiversity Protection Zones covering up to a total of 30% of Belize's Ocean.
- Objective 6 By November 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2029, develop legally enforceable Management Plans for Belize's Biodiversity Protection Zones as described in the MSP.
- Objective 7 Within one year of Cabinet's endorsement, commence implementation of legally enforceable management plans for Belize's Biodiversity Protection Zones.











-Goal three - Blue Economy Goal, was accepted with minor word change, from "To support the sustainable growth and development of Belize's blue economy in alignment with national legislative, policy, and planning frameworks." to "To support the sustainable growth and development of Belize's blue economy in alignment with legislation, policy, and planning frameworks."

For Goal three objective one, an alternate phrase was selected to replace "Identify and evaluate ocean spaces for spatial and temporal adequacy that supports projected sustainable expansion and management of traditional, existing, and emerging economic uses" with, "Identify and evaluate ocean spaces for their functional suitability to support projected sustainable expansion and management of traditional, existing and emerging economic uses."

For Goal three objective three, "Identify capacity needs to support national participation in investment and development of Belize's blue economy", there was a concern that this objective goes beyond the scope of the MSP Process, so it was removed.

#### Objectives:

- Objective 1 Identify and evaluate ocean spaces for their functional suitability to support projected sustainable expansion and management of traditional, existing and emerging economic uses.
- Objective 2 Mapping, measuring, and monitoring of blue carbon ecosystems to meet conservation targets and leverage conservation financing opportunities.
- -Goal four Equity, "To ensure fair and equitable access for all Belizeans to benefits derived from marine resources and spaces, with respect for traditional social, environmental, cultural and economic uses", was accepted and approved as is with no changes.

#### Objectives:

- Objective 1 Between August 2022 and November 2026, implement a stakeholder engagement plan ensuring that 75% of quarterly targets for engaging with key multi-sectoral interest groups are met.
- Objective 2 Identify cultural, indigenous, social, and economic uses, through stakeholder engagement, to determine the allocation of ocean spaces to safeguard community traditions, livelihoods, and participation in emerging sustainable economic activities.
