3.1	The MSP GIS Mapping and Spatial Analyst summarized the SeaSketch:		
	Ocean Use Survey (OUS) Training Workshop held on November 15 and		
	16 at the Best Western Plus Belize Biltmore Plaza:		
	- The workshop trained 27 individuals from 12 organizations on the		
	OUS tool, used for capturing the spatial distribution of human activities		
	and for planning purposes.		
	- Feedback from workshop participants and Steering Committee		
	members highlighted several suggestions for the improvement of the		
	survey tool.		
3.2	The MSP Science Lead facilitated a three-day engagement in northern		
	Belize from November 27 to 29. Coastal community leaders from		
	Sarteneja Village, Chunox Village, Copper Bank Village, and Consejo		
	Village discussed the current status of the BSOP process and the next		
	phase utilizing the OUS. They also identified target groups to be		
	included in the OUS, such as ferry and boat operators, regattas and		
	sailing clubs, developers, marine conservationists, beach trap		
	associations, fly fishers, fisherfolk associations, women's groups, and		
	transportation of goods. Feedback from the visit emphasized various		











	approaches for community engagement, including snowball methods,	
	face-to-face interactions, group sessions, and home visits.

5.1	Monitoring & Evaluation (M&E) consultancy update was provided by	
	The Nature Conservancy, indicating that Praxi5 was the selected	
	consultant. The consultancy is contracted for eight (8) months.	
	Expected output are:	
	- Development of indicators, targets, and methods from M&E	
	- Develop stakeholder engagement assessment report,	
	providing lessons learnt from stakeholder engagement phase	
	two (2) report and recommendations.

Zone Management (ICZM) process, with major knowledge gap being			
the exclusive economic zone (EEZ).			

The People Centric Conservation Agenda (PCCA) has its agenda of protection coral reef areas which has synergy that can be aligned with the BSOP in the form of a Spatial Analyst Support. The position will work towards ensuring the fulfillment of the works and assist the current MSP GIS Mapping and Spatial Analyst with the development of an official coral reef layer for Belize.

Participatory mapping will refine the ICZM baselines and provide the current situation related to the use of space. The participatory mapping will be done repeatedly to understand the evolving use of space to identify trends of use that will assist with future planning and conflict resolutions.

Non-spatial information is being collected with the use of the Technical Working Groups (TWGs) that are sector specific. Data is also being collected from partners and sectors. With the census data being waited for, for the refinement of targets.

For refinement and the best way forward, other decision-support tools have been identified: Marxan (to identify biodiversity protection zones), and marine invest (from Natural Capital, for the justification of use of space for future planning).
